Principal Mr. Hanke:

- Student enrollment is up from 500 to 502. Two more students are currently being assessed to bring enrollment to a total of 504 students.
- Mrs. Romero has resigned from her EA position to take a part time teaching position at J.M. Young School.
- Aleah Skibinsky has moved into a full time EA position. Kyra Kaspick has been hired in a part time position and Jhoy Cruz is moving from an EA position at NACI to HMK.
- Enrollment is up 190 kids since September, the only rooms that are left in the school that aren't classrooms are the gym, music room, library and staff room.
- 7 additional classrooms have been ordered for the middle school. Eventually the grade 4 students will have to move over to the middle school. Each grade currently has 5 classes.
- The new Manitoba government is still planning on building some new schools but are looking at going the more traditional route instead of the 3P model.
- The government is also looking at introducing a \$30 million dollar nutrition program

Vice-Principal Mr. Freeman:

- Ian Porteous was at HMK for 4 schools playing music for the kids and teaching them dances.
- Val Caldwell presented to the Grade 4 students about internet and social media safety.
- Noon skating is ending in February. It ran from December- February.

Old Business:

The cookbooks are currently sitting at a profit for \$300.

New Business:

Make it sow fundraiser is going to run from February 7-22.

The parent council asks to have teacher requests in for the next meeting. Spring fling and teacher appreciation with be discussed at the next meeting.
