HMK Parent Council Minutes: January 31, 2022

Meeting was called to order at 6:33. There were 4 people in attendance: Principal Mr. Hanke and 3 council members: President Sarah McKinnon, Treasurer Heather Saquet and Secretary Leslie Pearson.

Review of Agenda: Heather Saquet made a motion to adopt agenda as presented. Leslie Pearson seconded motion. Carried.

Reviews of Minutes: minutes from November 15 meeting were posted to website. Heather Saquet made a motion to adopt previous meeting minutes. Leslie Pearson seconded motion. Carried.

No new correspondence was reported.

Reports:

President Sarah Mckinnon: nothing to report

Treasurer Heather Saquet: Total in account of \$4029.92. Donation from Beautiful Plains School Division of \$300 was deposited in account in January and \$70 was spent for fruit trays for HMK staff in December.

Principal Mr. Hanke:

- HMK enrollment is up 18 kids from our last meeting for a current total of 462 students.
- Mrs. Pollock had knee surgery and is on leave for the next few months; she is currently being covered by Mrs. Fischer.
- Parents have been doing an excellent job of keeping the school informed when students have tested positive for Covid or are isolating.
- Mrs. Ernest and Mrs. Plett have been doing a great job of answering many phone calls from parents and staying up to date on isolation requirements.
- The province changed school protocol for Covid and the school is no longer required to do contact tracing.
- After January 14th, HMK is no longer doing remote learning (as per direction from the province). If a teacher chooses, they may still to do some remote sessions with students that are isolating at home.
- It is recommended students wear 3-layer masks but it is not required.
- A vaccine clinic was held at HMK on January 25. Approximately 100 doses were administered.

Old Business: none

New Business:

- Heather Saquet suggested Parent Council put together covid care packages for students and staff. They will contain items for sanitizing as well as over the counter medications. Heather Saquet made a motion to provide Covid Care Packages to families in need with the assistance of HMK staff for an initial supply limit of \$500 to be re-evaluated with need. Leslie Pearson seconded. Carried.
- Staff appreciation options were discussed for individual servings of treats for staff. There are 45 staff members. We will discuss again at next meeting in March.
