With last week's announcement that school staff will start working at school on June 1st, and that limited use of school facilities is now permitted, we wanted to provide some clarification as to what this means. Please see the attached letter from Mr. Young, BPSD Superintendent, regarding limited use of school facilities (both English and Tagalog versions are attached). In Mr. Young's letter, you will note that at-home learning will continue until the end of June, and that some teachers may ask to meet with individual or small groups of students, but this type of meeting will be set up in advance and is completely at the discretion of parents. If your child does come to the school, there is a set of screening questions that will need to be answered by you prior to your child coming into the school. The screening questions are also attached (both in English and Tagalog). If you have any questions about any of this, please be sure to contact the school right away so we can help make sure there are no misunderstandings.

The final attachment is from Manitoba Public Insurance, and pertains to bicycle safety. With spring weather finally here, many kids are finally able to get outside to run, play, and ride their bikes. For the last few years, MPI has come to HMK in the spring and held a bicycle rodeo for our grade 2 students. Unfortunately, that will not be able to happen for our current grade 2 students. Seeing as they can not come out to schools, they wanted to provide some basic bike safety information. Please look over the document from MPI, and go over it with each of your children so they know these important bike riding safety precautions and rules. Wearing helmets, and stopping at stop signs, are two of the things we most often hear that are being ignored by children when riding their bikes. Please continue to talk to your children throughout the summer about safe bike riding practices, so everyone has a safe and fun summer! Thank you for your ongoing support!
